Jacob Baumgardner (D. 1846)	Ca. Co.	Ca. Co. Will JB 1-435 (1846) Two pairs of gravestones one for myself and for my wife Magdalene. Both were originally buried at Conewago Chapel, but were later removed to St. Aloysius’ Catholic Cemetery in 1937. Littlestown PA. Land where farm is located was willed by Samuel Bennett (1749-1817) to son Rezin Bennett 1780-1835 (Ba. Co. Will Vol. 10-280 1817). Rezin Bennett 1780-1835 willed the farm to his nephew Samuel Bennett (of Samuel) Ba. Co. Will Vol. 15-249 1835. Ca. Co. Deed JBB 43-446 1874 .Samuel T. Bennett (D. 1882) is granted the estate of Samuel Bennett (of Samuel). Samuel T. Bennett (D. 1882) is buried at Old Oakland Cemetery Eldersburg MD. No headstones found. Deed WW 6-263 157 Acres). Samuel Carr 1794-1864 willed the farm (Ca. Co. Will JMP 3-267 1864) to his grandson Samuel Carr (Son of James W. Carr). Carroll Co. Cemeteries (Carr Family5-43). The Carr Family Cemetery is mentioned in Howard and Ruth Carr's <i>Family History of Samuel and Sidney Carr and Their Descendants</i>. (Maryland Jesse P. Carr (1874-1943) said there was a stone house standing about 500 feet in front of the barn. About the same distance in front of the house was the cemetery. There was also a slave cemetery located south of the house on a knoll. This property was known as

Shew/Shuey (Wife of Henry Shew/Shuey) 1824-1863		the Dorsey Farm because Samuel Carr, a native of Ireland, bought it from Archibald Dorsey in 1841. Samuel married Sidney Ann Randall in 1820 and they are buried side by side. The Carr family owned this land for 112 years. Information not found on Find A Grave. Conoway Family Zachariah Conoway D. 1848 Helen Conoway (Wife)	Ca. Co.	Carroll County Cemeteries 6-31-Update. States in 1948 two gravestones were found (Zachariah Conoway D. 1848 & ?, Garretson D. 1815) in a dump near Bollinger Mill Road & Mineral Hill Road. Also reported as many as 25 headstones were under fill dirt. Zachariah Conoway D. 1848 willed to his sons (Ca. Co. Will 1-492 1848) Zachariah & Charles Conoway 125 acres part of Conoways Venture Improved & Beasemans Discovery Enlarged that was willed to him by his father Charles Conoway (1748-1811) Ba. Co. Will 9-154 1811). Charles Conoway (1748-1811) also willed farms to sons Joshua & Archibald Conoway. John Conoway (1717-1799) patented Conoways Venture Improved (Ba. Co. # 1179 368 Acres 1769). Members of the Conoway Family are known to be living in this area on into the late 1800's as shown in the early Carroll County Atlas maps. Location of the two headstones is unknown. Jonathan Manro died in 1848 and the estate ended up in Chancery Court. Baltimore Sun 4 Dec 1849 advertised sale of the farm by decree of the Chancery Court. States “Valuable farm of 520 acres which formerly belonged to James Conner and afterwards Jonathan Manro both deceased and is now in the possession of George W. Manro with the family burial ground reserved”. The farm was purchased by George W. Manro (Ca. Co. Deed JBB 11-488 1850 & Ca. Co. Deed JBB 17-15 1854). Unknown if James Conner and wife & Jonathan Manro and wife were moved or still remain in the family burial ground. George W. Manro 1810-1891 was the son of Jonathan Manro (1766-1848) & Sarah Conner. Sarah Manro was the daughter of James Conner D. 1819 and Elizabeth Conner. Democratic Advocate 30 May 1891. George W. Manro (1810-1891) and wife Elizabeth Manro (1811-1891) were buried at Wesley Freedom United Methodist Church Eldersburg MD Manro Farm Johnsville Road & Sykesville Road Eldersburg MD. Will Vol. 3-370 1778) States "Wife Katherine Davis to live in my dwelling house until my youngest son comes of age 21 then the land be divided between my sons Rezin, Mathias, Samuel, Zachariah and Thomas Davis and daughters Lucy & Nancy Davis". Zachariah Davis obtained the land where the graveyard is located. Zachariah Davis D. 1829 wills (Ba. Co. Will Vol. 13-191 1829) to his wife Elizabeth Davis the estate until her death. Then upon her death to their children Cordelia, Amos, Ezra, Thomas, Susan, William, Zachariah, Amelia and Elizabeth. In 1845 Cordelia & Amelia Davis obtained the land from the heirs (Ca. Co. Deed JS 6-136 166 Acres). Cordelia Davis the sold the land to her brother in law Samuel England in 1856 (Ca. Co. Deed JBB 19-334). Samuel England sold the land to Leonard C. Frost in 1858 (Ca. Co. Deed GEW 24-113) with graveyard. Leonard C. Frost sells back to Samuel England 40 acres in 1858 which includes the graveyard (Ca. Co. Deed GEW 24-393). Samuel England sells the land after the deaths of Cordelia & Amelia Davis with burial ground in 1863 to Elizabeth Jewett (Ca. Co. Deed GEW 29-358). Cordelia age 53 & Amelia Davis age 43 appear in the 1850 Ca.		

		Co. Census living with Samuel England. Amelia Davis last appears in the 1860 Ca. Co. Census living with Samuel England. Only farm buildings left is the barn. William Devilbiss (1790-1834) died intestate with land sold by his wife Harriett Devilbiss in 1837 (Ca. Co. Deed WW 1-26 120.25 acres-Except burying ground). William Devilbiss (1790-1834) headstone is at the Uniontown Methodist Cemetery Uniontown MD. Unknown if it was moved there or was this the original location. Harriett Devilbiss (1790-1841) died New Bethel Indiana graveyard location unknown. The burying ground referred to in the deed is the same as Carroll Co. Cemetery Records Runnymede (aka Nusbaum) 2-18 on Baust Church Road Westminster MD. Obituary in Democrat Advocate 19 October 1900 states he died in Westminster but was a resident of Massachusetts. Buried in Durbin Family burial ground near Westminster MD. Samuel Durbin (1698-1752) Ann Logsdon Durbin 1703-1770 William Durbin (1726-1773)	Ca. Co.	The land where the graveyard was located was obtained in 1752 by Samuel Durbin 1698-1752 (Ba. Co. Deed TR D-361 150 Acres Tract-Cobbs Choice). Samuel Durbin (1698-1752) willed (Fr. Co. Will Book A-78 1752) to his son William Durbin (1726-1773) 100 acres and his son Samuel Durbin (1727-1808) 50 acres part of Cobbs Choice. William Durbin (1726-1773) obtained the land where the graveyard is located and confirmed by Fr. Co. Deed M-433 1769 100 Acres. William Durbin (1726-1773) left no will. Only probate record found is his inventory (Fr. Co. Inventory Book C-145 1773). Land then went to his son William Durbin (1749-1820) who willed the land to his son Nicholas Durbin (Fr. Co. Will HS 3-393 1820). Were the early Durbin Family members listed owning the land buried there?

Mary Polson Durbin 1722-1800 William Durbin 1749-1820 Margaret Bruce Durbin 1749-1808		Carroll County Cemetery List (Durbin Family 5-53) Paul Beard supplied the Carroll County Genealogical Society with information about the disappearance of this cemetery. The tombstones were removed and given to either the Westminster United Methodist Church or to Western Maryland College, but the bodies were not disinterred. The removal took place before Paul Beard's father sold his property to Earl Griswold perhaps sometime in the 1960s or 1970s. Mr. Beard was a farmer and was tired of plowing around the small cemetery. No identified burials. The 1767 Durbin House still stands. Aquila Garrettson 1758- 1837		Aquila Garrettson D. 1837 (Ca. Co. Will JB 1-25 1837) states “Reserve a piece of ground sufficient for 6 graves between the chestnut tree and the barn where I desire to be buried. 1837 Carroll County MD. Tax list Aquilia Garrettson with 18 acres of the Tract-Flagg Meadow. This matches the area indicated where the headstone was located. Co. Patent# 333 149 Acres) in 1773. John Gilliss enlarged the tract by Patent-York County (Ba. Co. Unpatented #1785 470 Acres) in 1794. John Gilliss dies in 1806 (Ba. Co. Admin Bond Vol. 9 507) with no will located. Araminta Gilliss Shipley (eldest daughter of John Gilliss) obtained her portion of her fathers land. Araminta Gilliss Shipley dies intestate in 1815 and Adam Shipley (son of Araminta Gilliss Shipley) in 1820 petitioned the court to divide the land (Ba. Co. Deed WG 158-410). The land where the graveyard is located went to her daughter Susannah Gilliss (married Richard U. Condon). The graveyard isn’t mentioned until 1892 (Ca. Co. Deed BFC 75-339) Grafton L. Condon to Edward Bire except ¾ acre enclosed as a graveyard for the family or descendants of Araminta Shipley.	

Daughter Araminta Gilliss Shipley 1772-1815 Husband John Shipley 1768-1840 Susannah Gilliss Condon 1813-1872	Bethel Road & Woodbine Road Area of 39.424128° -77.056577° Note Find a Grave shows the headstone of John Gilliss 1732-1806 located at the Ebenezer Methodist Church Cemetery. Also states burial location as Jenkins/Gilliss Cemetery at Krimgold Park Woodbine where a graveyard is now surrounded by a chain link fence. Currently who is actually buried here is unknown. Araminta Gilliss Shipley & John Shipley are also shown at Ebenezer United Methodist Church Cemetery. The persons listed died before Ebenezer Methodist Church Cemetery was established with headstones moved at a later date. Question: did they come from the burial ground listed above or another location? Carroll County Cemeteries Condon Family 7-12 The Condon Family Cemetery consists of some fieldstones plus three inscribed stones. It is located on the north side of Bethel Road off Woodbine Road. George Wetzel, Doris Manzer and Frances Bellinger copied the inscriptions in 1982. Only one stone had a complete inscription, the other two markers were footstones with initials.
