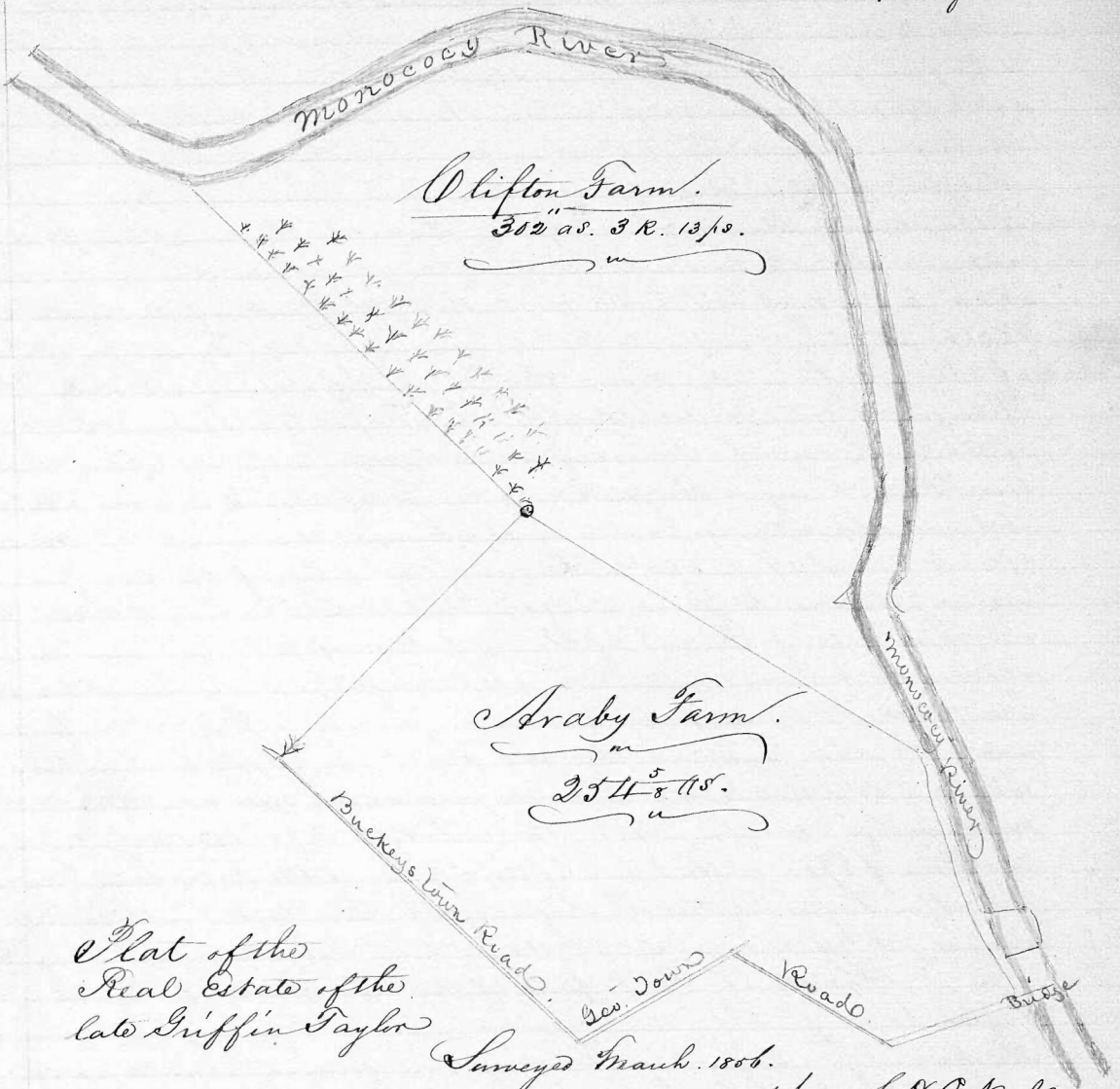

Courses and distances of the Clifton Farm "part of the Real Estate of the late Griffin Taylor, being part of a Tract called 'Wash Work' Resurveyed" and part of the Resurvey on Archadia" part of Araby " & part of the Resurvey on The Hermitage. Beginning at a Stone pillar at the end of 147 1/2 ps. on the first line of the Tract aforesaid called "Araby" it being at the end of the 12th or 36 1/4th E 196 1/2 ps. line of the deed from Griffin Taylor to Daniel & Edward Baker for 380 as. & running thence by and with said Deed reversed. Correcting the same S 37° W 196 1/2 ps. to a large Rock Oak tree marked with 12 notches S 37° W 7 1/10 ps. to Monococy River then up said River with the meanders thereof N 19 1/4° W 24 ps. N 35 1/4° W 92 ps. N 19 1/4° W 32 ps. N 52° E 43 1/10 ps. to the end of the 36th line of the Resurvey on Archadia" being on the east side of Monococy then by and with the 37th line thereof N 65 1/2° W 9 ps. to the middle of Monococy River then up by and with the channel of Monococy River then up by & with the middle thereof until it intersects the 33rd line of the Resurvey on Archadia
