Joseph Davis Family Bible

The front page is signed, "Joseph Davis - 1848"; date of publication, 1845.

Joseph was a lawyer and never married, but he purchased his father's estate from his siblings after the death of his mother. He had this house completed shortly before his death.



The bible entries are for his parents and siblings.

The bible was last known to be in possession of Helen (Tanner) Miller Terry who shared the data, but declined to make copies due the frail condition of the bible. She was the widow of Woodrow Miller who was the son of Winnie (Davis) & David Miller. Winnie's father, John Wesley Davis, was a son of Aaron Davis. Helen died in 2007. Note - Two of Joseph's brothers not listed were: Edward b/ Jan 1, 1817; d/ Aug 2, 1825; and John Winter Davis, the eldest, b/ Mar 22, 1813; d/ Aug 9, 1877 (he had his father's bible).
