Birthplace: Groveton, Texas

Hytha was the last child born to the union of Robert Reynolds and Candiest (Wortham) Reynolds Beamon. For all of her life she was fondly Called "The Baby" by her two older sisters.

She affiliated with the Church at a very early age, and was baptized in the old mill pond in Groveton. Over the years she was a devoted church member, a willing worker, and in her words, "A child of God." At her demise she was an active member of Long Chapel C. M. E. Church where she was secretary of Stewardess Board #2 and former musician of the Gospel Choir.

She attended elementary and Jr. High School in Groveton & Lufkin, Texas and graduated from San Bernadine High School in San Bernadino, California at the tender age of 16. She immediately enrolled in the Henrietta Beauty School in Los Angeles, CA, following a few years first at Salons in Hollywood, then in San Deigo CA. She trained to be a cosmetology instructor and taught cosmetology for seventeen years. She was an instructor at the Academy of Hair Design in Lufkin and owner/operator of Step Into Elegance Hair Salon at the time of her death.

Hytha was a member of the Top Ladies of Distinction, Alpha Chi Pi Omega Sorority, Negro Business and Professional Association, National Cosmetology Association, International Hair Weaving Association, International Teastmistress Association and Bronze Beauty Pageant Foundation of California.
