## WILLIAM HUTTO DURRANCE 1815-1879

William Hutto Durrance moved to the south Florida area about 1853 settling in eastern Hillsborough County which would later be sliced off in the creation of Polk County. William was born on August 31, 1815 in Tattnall County, Georgia, a son of Joseph Durrance and Cecilia Tippins. He married Sarah Harriet Robertson on May 9, 1844 probably in Lowndes Co., Georgia. She was born February 6, 1823 in South Carolina. Their children were:
