On March 17, 1862, Alford Sloan registered the following mark and brand with the Manatee County Clerk's office: crop and two underbits in each ear, brand "AS".

Alford was a member of Company B, 1st Battalion Florida Special Cavalry of the Confederate Army. His father was a first lieutenant in this company. This unit was a part of Col. Munnerlyn's "Cow Cavalry".

Prior to 1870, Alford Sloan & family moved to Sumter County, Fla. They were listed there in the 1870 and 1880 census. Celia died August 5, 1881 and was buried in Dukes Cemetery at Groveland, Florida.

Alford married in Polk County on Feb. 3, 1882, Josephine Parker. Alford died about 1892 and place of burial is unknown.
