## JOHN KEEN 1825-1889

John Keen was born in Tattnall County, Georgia about 1825 son of David Keen. Although his tombstone states that he was born May 15, 1820, all of the census records and pension applications indicate that he was born about 1825. About 1832 John moved to Columbia County, Fl. along with his parents and other relatives.

On March 11, 1847 at Lake City in Columbia County, Florida he married Candacia "Candy" Morgan. She was born January 1832. They had six children according to her pension application:

- 1. Arthur Keen, born May 20, 1848; died March 18, 1900; married in Polk County, Florida on November 2, 1873, Nancy C. Hancock, daughter of Jordan and Martha J. (Baker) Hancock.
- 2. Noah E. Keen, born December 2, 1854; died June 21, 1912; married on November 28, 1880, Sarah Jane Keen, daughter of Henry H. and Mary Jane (Gill) Keen.
- 3. Joseph S. Keen, born March 23, 1857; married 1st, Fanny who died 1883; married 2nd, Mallisia (Melaci) "Lacey" Boyd.
- 4. Elias Keen, born March 3, 1869; married in Hillsborough County on May 12, 1891, Lula Clark.
- 5. Jesse Keen, born May 25, 1873; died August 3, 1890.
- 6. John B. Keen, born May 18, 1875; married October 3, 1897, Vivian Roberts.

Miles Keen, born 1852 and Elizabeth Keen, born 1859 were listed in household of John & Candy Keen in the 1860 census and were thought to be their children but when Mrs. Candacia Keen applied for a widow's pension she stated that they had only six children and listed their birth dates from her old family Bible.
