

Enoch Collins, Jr. died on January 31, 1907 and was buried in New Hope Cemetery in Hardee County. Mrs. Victoria Collins made an application for a widow's pension. On July 1907 she was living at Fredonia in Polk County, Florida. On Feb. 11, 1908 general affidavits were filed from C. L. Wilder, age 64, resident of Plant City and James N. Collins, age 66, resident of Plant City in support of Mrs. Collins' pension. Victoria A. Collins died December 2, 1909 and was buried beside her husband in New Hope Cemetery.
