ISAAC HUGH STONE 1870-1925

Isaac Hugh Stone was born September 3, 1870 in Calhoun County, Florida. A fourth generation Floridian, Hugh was the oldest of nine children of Shade Sutton and Olive Elizabeth (Griffin) Stone. His paternal grandparents were Isaac Hugh and Caroline (Wood) Stone. Paternal great-grandparents were Henry Dassex and Elizabeth (Hansford) Stone. Henry D. Stone, son of Thomas and Frances (Guerin) Stone, moved from Montgomery County, Alabama to Jackson County, Florida in the early 1820's and served as president of the first elected Legislative Council of Florida in 1826.

Hugh was listed with his parents in the 1880 Calhoun County census. Sometimes afterwards the family moved to Sneads, Jackson County, Fla. In 1900 the family owned a 222 acre farm in Sneads. Shade, a veteran of Company H, 5th Florida, C.S.A., was partially disabled by injuries sustained at Sharpsburg and Cold Harbor during the Civil War; subsequently, Hugh while still a very young man assumed the management of the family farm.

Isaac Hugh Stone married on November 25, 1903 in Cypress, Florida Lula Viola Williams. The daughter of Thomas Franklin and Sophronia (McClelland) Williams, Viola was born January 22, 1879 in Tifton, Ga. Hugh and Viola had six children:

1. Jewel Stone, born June 13, 1905, Sneads; died July 17, 1972, Hialeah, Fl.; married 1st, William C. Hooker, son of William Henry and Mahala (Langford) Hooker, grandson of Stephen P. & Sarah (Carlton) Hooker and Henry & Jane (Whidden) Langford; married 2nd, Lloyd Dennison.
2. Tracy Hugh Stone, born June 24, 1908, Sneads; died July 10, 1972, Bowling Green, Fl.; married April 1, 1939 Anne Rae Hendry, daughter of James Madison and Martha Frances (Wingate) Hendry.
