

JOSEPH JOHN PAYNE 1813-1861

Joseph John Payne, son of George and Sarah (Smith) Payne, was born 1813, Laurens County, Georgia. He married about 1832, Martha Henrietta Smith, born 1815 in Georgia, daughter of William and Mary (Ellis) Smith. They had the following children:

1. Ira Payne, born 1833. (1850 Laurens Co., Ga. Census has his name as Jerry while the 1860 Hamilton Co., Fla. Census has his name as Ira.) He enlisted as a private on July 28, 1862 in Georgia in the Confederate Army and was captured at Marietta, Georgia on June 18, 1864 and died of measles at Camp Morton, Indiana on July 20, 1864. He apparently never married.
2. Sarah Payne, born November 16, 1835; died December 20, 1897, buried New Zion Cemetery, Ona, Fla.; married on November 12, 1857 in Hamilton County, Fla., John Wright Hendry, son of Robert and Zilla Ann (Moody) Hendry.
3. Robert T. Payne, born 1839. He enlisted as a private on April 28, 1862 in the Confederate Army in Georgia, was appointed corporal, captured at Franklin, Tennessee on December 17, 1864. Paroled at Camp Chase, Ohio on May 2, 1865, he was received at Vicksburg, Mississippi via New Orleans, Louisiana for exchange May 12, 1865. He went west after release.
4. Joseph John Payne, Jr., born 1841. He enlisted as a private on May 27, 1861 in Georgia in the Confederate Army. He was wounded at Salem Church, Virginia on May 3, 1863 and died from his wounds on May 6, 1863. He apparently never married.
5. Mary Jane Payne, born June 3, 1842; died May 3, 1899, buried New Zion Cemetery, Ona, Fla.; married on December 22, 1858 in Hamilton County, Fla., James Madison Hendry, son of Robert and Zilla Ann (Moody) Hendry.
6. Martha Payne, born 1844.
7. Margaret Payne, born 1846.
8. Elizabeth Frances Payne, born December 1848; died April 11, 1913, buried New Zion Cemetery, Ona, Fla.; married on March 8, 1868 in Polk County, Fla., James H. Rich.
9. Lucinda Payne, born March 1850; died 1919, buried Joshua Creek Cemetery, Arcadia, Fla.; married on January 7, 1868 in Manatee County, Fla., Alderman Carlton, son of Daniel Wilson and Sallie Ann (Murphy) Carlton.
10. Dorinda Payne, born April 11, 1853; died April 4, 1926, buried Fort Green Methodist Cemetery, Fort Green, Fla.; married on January 7, 1869 in Polk County, Fla., Benjamin Alderman son of Matthew and Caroline (Sloan) Alderman.
